AUCTION RULES

- PNWCTA membership is not required
- Buyers need to be at the Christmas Tree & Farm Showcase or have a representative onsite to bid
- Bidding is open to all. This includes industry partners, retailers and growers.
- Minimum bid of \$18,000 USD is required to win the truckload of trees. If minimum is not hit, the load will NOT be sold.
- Winning bid receives 2026 PNWCTA membership (if not a member already)
- Tree quality will be a #1 grade or better
- Trees are provided by multiple growers to ensure a well-balanced mix of #1 grade trees.
- Once the set number of auctioned trees has been loaded, the truck will be sent whether it is full or not.
- Bidding will happen in writing at the show starting with the opening of the Trade Show.
- The Bidding sheet will be kept at the member services desk
- Bidding will continue through Saturday Morning and last call at 11:00 am
- The winner will be announced at the end of the speaker presentations on Saturday.
- The winning bidder must make payment in Full within 15 business days of winning the auction.
- Failure to pay within the time frame will result in the cover bidder being named as the winner. They too will have 15 business days to pay in full.
- The buyer must arrange their own shipping.
- Trees are all shipped FOB
- Shipping date must be submitted by buyer to loading coordinator no later than October 15, 2025 for approval.
- Loading coordinator must approve the final ship date with the buyer.
- Shipping must be coordinated with the load out supervisor.
- No substitutions to the list of auction trees.
- Buyer must disclose to load coordinator if any special Ag permits are required for their shipping destination.
- Load inventory is being determined but will be similar to 2024 tree load.
